

Morning Garden (Parent/Child)

Emerson Waldorf School will be offering the Morning Garden Program on Monday mornings during the school year. The Parent/Child program is designed to meet the social needs of the young child (birth to 3 years) with the loving support of the parents.

During the hours we meet, the children will play in a warm, nurturing environment that seeks to surround the child with a quiet reverence and adult gestures worthy of imitation. The parents will do a simple activity with a bit of discussion while the children are playing. We will clean up and have a simple story, then depart.

Included in the session is one evening to begin each session. As parents we recognize, intuitively, what is right for our children. During the evenings we are able to share our insights, observations and learn more about the rhythms of the Waldorf School.

Place: Nursery Building at EWS

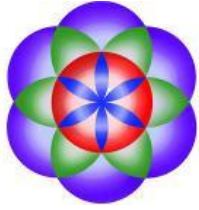
